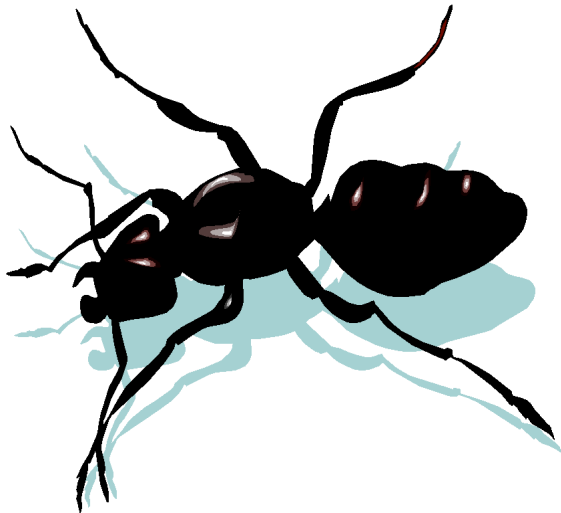
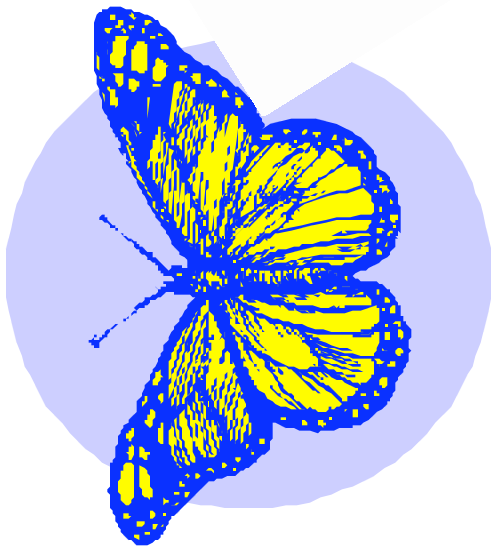

Page 1: Insect pop-up

Instructions and picture ideas for insect pop-up:

- 1) Fold page 3 in half along the fold line.
- 2) Fold page 2 in half along the fold line.
- 3) While page 2 is folded, cut out pop-up boxes on page 2 along the cut lines. Fold the 2 boxes backwards and forwards along the fold lines.
- 4) Open page 2, and push boxes out, so they stick out the front of page 2.
- 5) Draw 2 insects on another sheet of paper, a little larger than one side of each pop-up box. You can also use the insects on this page.
- 6) Glue one insect on one side of each pop-up box, so you have 2 insects that pop up when you hold the page sideways.
- 7) Pages 2 and 3 are glued together, after page 2 is finished.
- 8) Recycle this scrap paper.

There are some sample insects on this page, but use your library to find your own pictures, to give you some ideas.



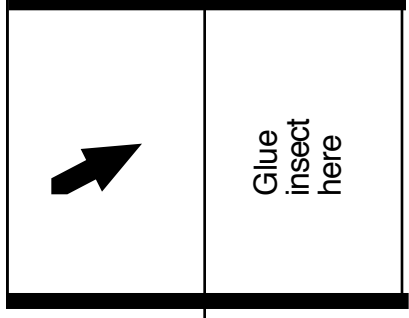
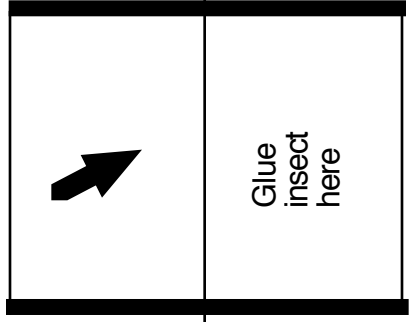
Page 2: Insect pop-up (front of page 2)
