

Page 1: Crayfish pop-up

Instructions and picture ideas for Crayfish pop-up:

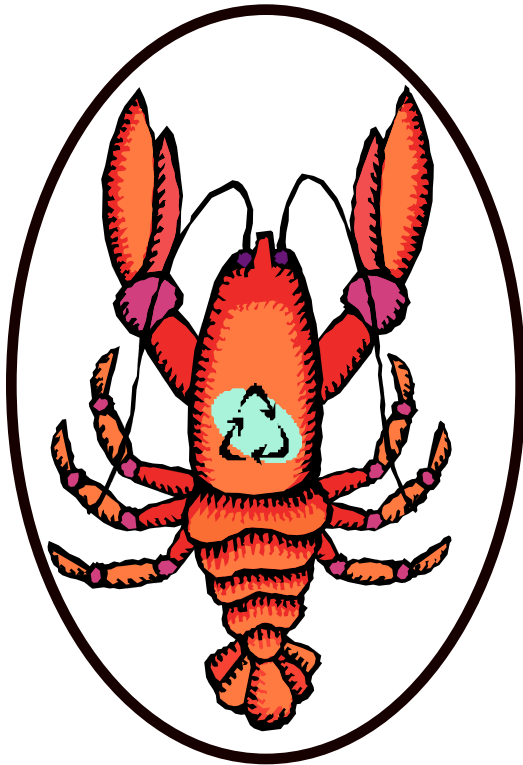
- 1) Fold page 3 in half along fold line.
- 2) Fold page 2 on half along the fold line.
- 3) Cut out pop-up boxes on page 2.
- 4) Push boxes out, so they stick out the front of page 2.
- 5) Draw a crayfish below, a little larger than one side of each pop-up box. You can also cut out and colour the crayfish on this page, and use it.
- 6) Glue the crayfish one side of the pop-up box, so you have a crayfish that pops up when you hold the page sideways.
- 7) Pages 2 and 3 are glued together, after page 2 is finished.
- 8) Recycle this paper as scrap paper.

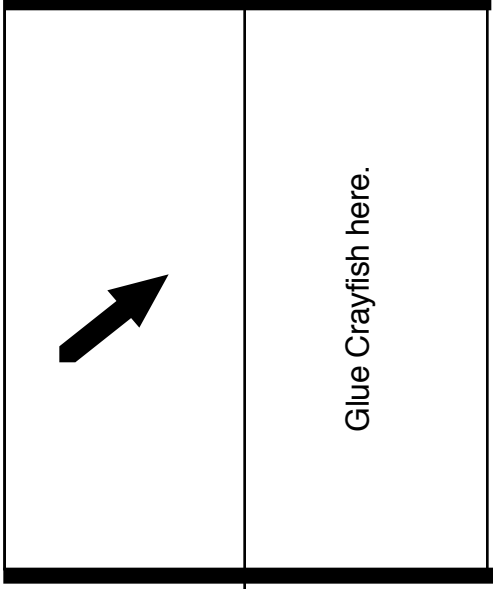

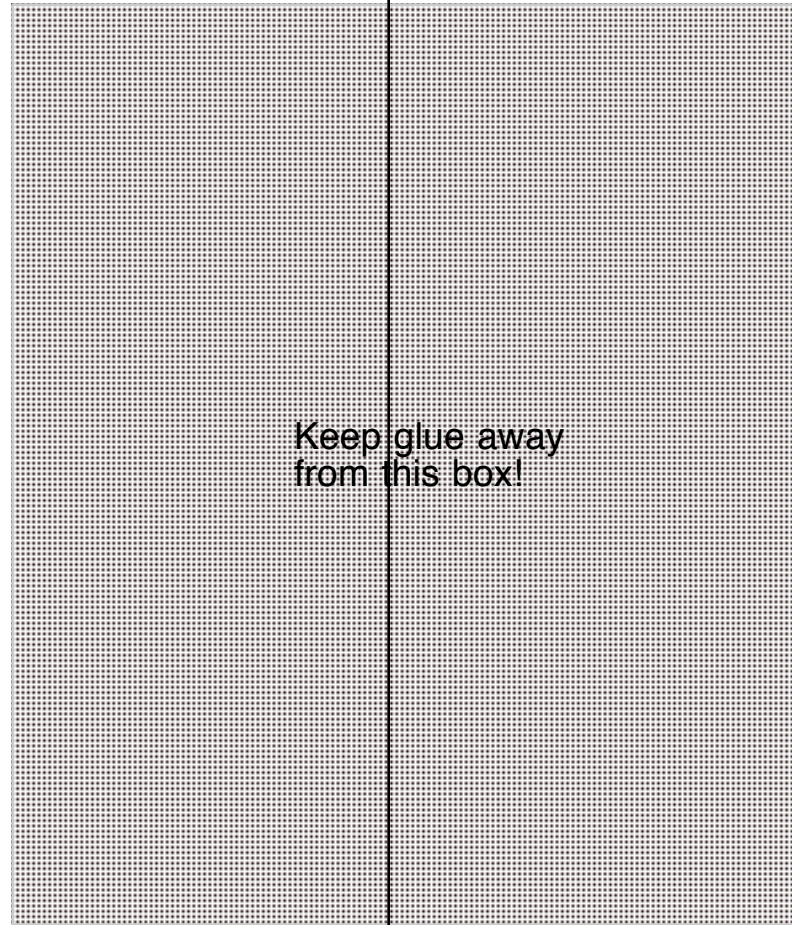
