

**Display Ancient Greece Kits**  
**And Share the Displays With Each Other**

- 1) You will be arranged in 5 groups, and given space to display your assigned kit.
- 2) Create a display of materials to be photographed for the web page, and to share with the other four groups. Pretend you are in the Agora, or Marketplace, in an ancient Greek city, and display the kit in an attractive manner, so your viewers will take an interest in it!
- 3) Write up the following evaluation.
- 4) The only way you will get the work done is to divide the assignment up, so each person does one part of it.
- 5) If there are videotapes of computer programs, make sure one or more group members previews part of the program, and describes the videotape or computer program.
- 6) NOTE: It is very important each group member remember how the kit was organized, so it can be put back in exactly the same order, with no pieces missing, at the end of the display! Do not remove any items from the display, unless you remember to put them right back!
- 7) 7) If you finish early, browse some of the book resources on display, or ask your teacher if your group can help one of the other groups with their display.
