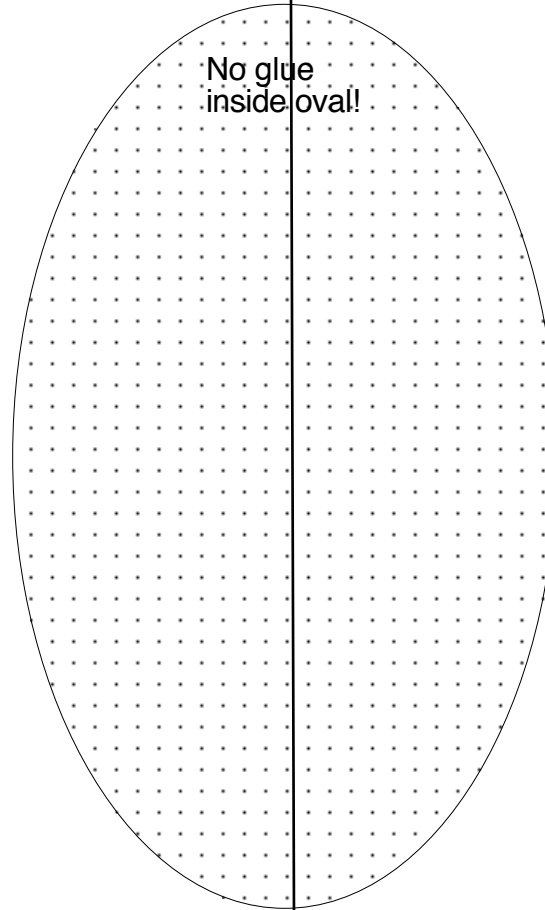

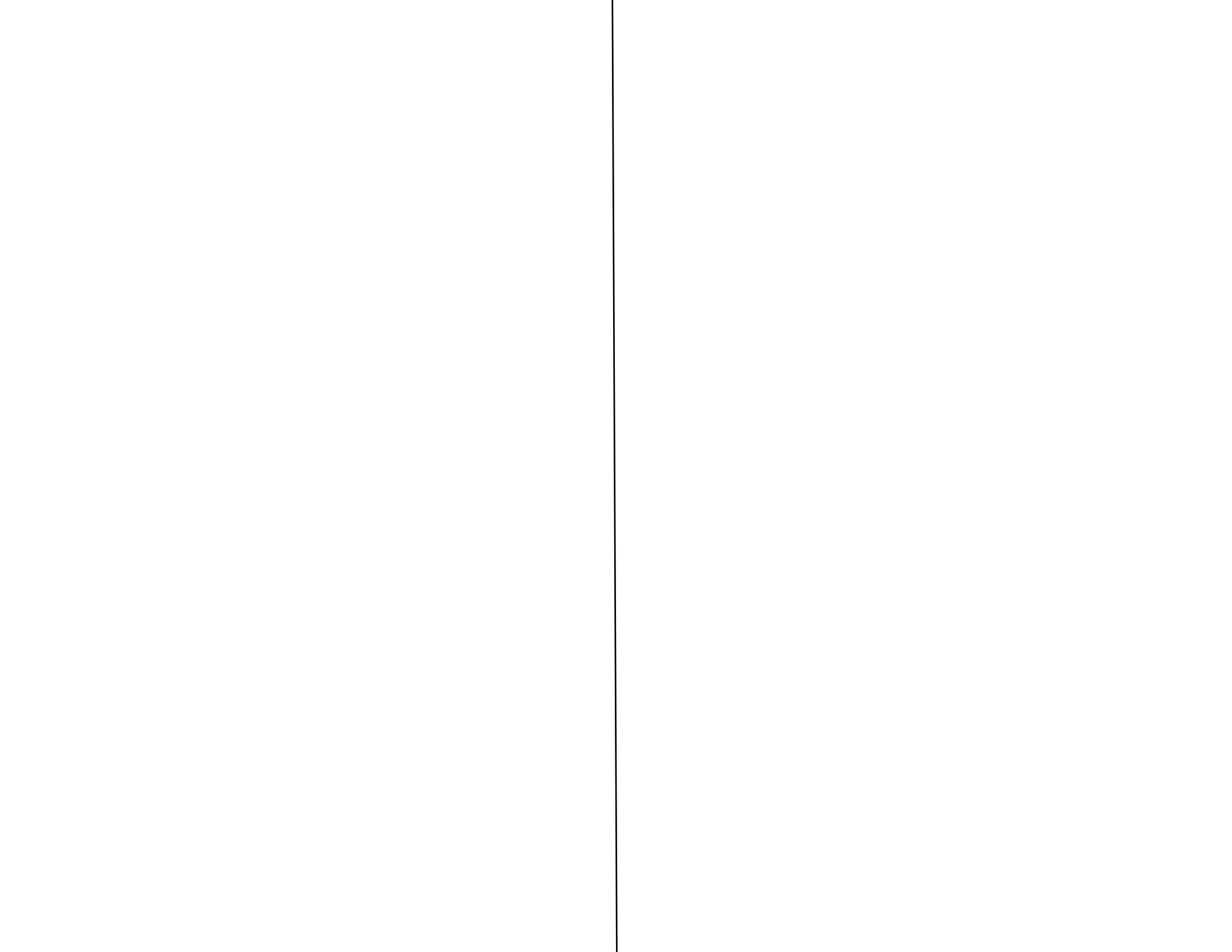

Page 1: Spider pop-up instructions (Note: Print out or copy the spider pages as double-sided pages)

Directions:

- 1) Fold page 2 in half along fold line.
- 3) Cut out spider fangs along the cut line, while the sheet is folded.
- 4) While the sheet is folded, fold the pyramid shaped fold lines above the fangs, backwards and forwards
- 5) Open the page with the spider picture showing, and push the fangs out along pyramid fold lines, so the fangs pop out when the card is closed.
- 5) Color the spider picture.
- 6) Fold this page along the fold line.
- 7) Glue this page as a backing for your spider pop-up, but do not put glue near the oval on this page.



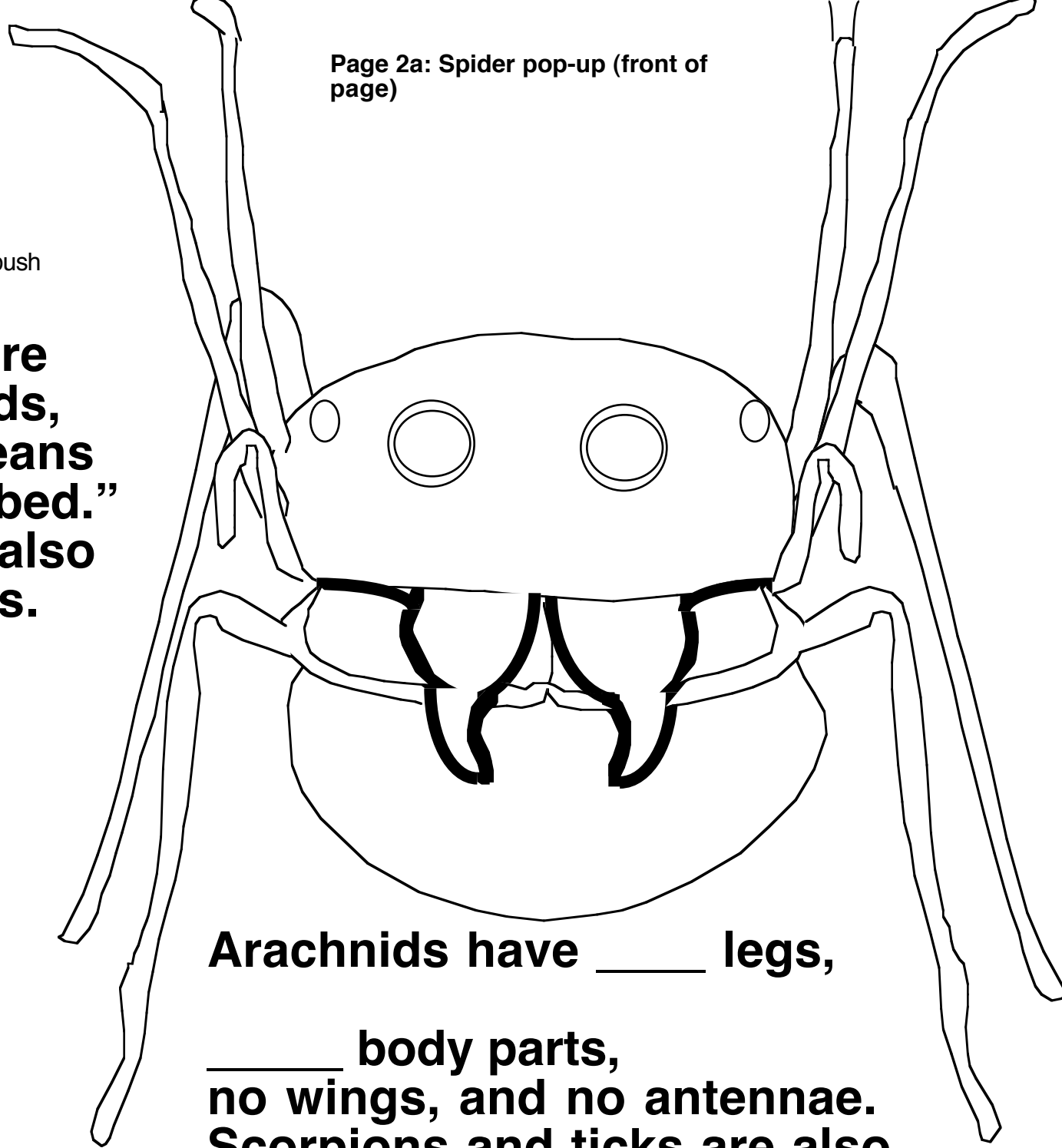
