Lethbridge has an assortment of ethnic restaurants that offer a delicious variety of food experiences for all tastes. A few of the selections are:

**O-Sho Japanese Restaurant** – tasty meals and beautifully-crafted sushi are served to you by waitresses in traditional Japanese garb. Enjoy your food in a Japanese-style low booth with cushions.

**The Lighthouse** - a unique sushi restaurant where the chefs can interact with the guests.

**Abyssinian Restaurant** – home-style Ethiopian food served in a communal platter style.

**Baadshah Royal East Indian Cuisine, Taj East Indian Cuisine** – two excellent choices serving mouth-watering dishes catering to both Indian and Western tastes.
