What's the Same?


Classes often get out after dark, so follow the same strategies you would at SAIT:

- Arrange to walk with friends to the C-train or parking lot.
- If you miss your friends, contact Security **Safe Walk** to escort you.
- Stay in busy, well-lit areas & stay in the centre of the sidewalk.
- On C-train platforms, stay in view of the camera, near the HELP intercom.
- Walk confidently, but pay attention to your surroundings.
- If you sense trouble, trust your instincts & leave immediately.

What's Different?

All classes are in one building and security is located on the main floor of that building.

- Bow Valley Campus Security runs the Safe Walk program covering a 2 block radius. Go to the security desk, or phone 403-410-1713. This is also the number for emergencies (you may want to program it into your cell phone).
- Campus is locked in the evenings so those who don't belong don't get in.
- Security patrols regularly & may check your **U of L ID card.** Have it with you.
- We are now in a busy restaurant & theatre district, but you should still be cautious & plan for your own safety.
