



Your Role as an Applied Study Faculty Supervisor

Disciplinary Credit Applied Study courses are designed so that students may use a paid or volunteer work placement to relate practical experience in an academic context. Disciplinary Credit Applied Studies can be completed at the 2, 3 or 4000 level and are completed in conjunction with a Faculty Supervisor. Your role as a Faculty Supervisor includes . . .

- discussing with and approving a student's learning objectives in the context of their work experience
- discussing with the student an appropriate final project format & length for the course level
- acting as an academic resource to the student throughout the project (students are advised to maintain regular contact with their Faculty Supervisor)
- grading and evaluating the final project; constituting 70% of the student's grade†
