6. Count the number of trestles on the High Level Bridge.
7. Take pictures of at least one team member in front of the Pronghorn Statue (NOTE: Additional point will be awarded for funny poses).
8. Name the UofL radio station.
9. Where does the water from the Oldman River eventually drain?
10. How tall and how long is the High Level Bridge?
11. Who is the current Geography Department Chair at the University of Lethbridge?
12. How many golf courses are there in Lethbridge?
13. What is the latitude and longitude of the Alberta Water and Environmental Science Building (AWESB)?
14. Bring an empty used cup from Penny Coffee House, Esquires Coffee or Round Street Café.
15. Two points for each WDCAG Poster from your team (List the first presenter for each of these posters).
16. What is the official name of the High Level Bridge?
17. Name the Mayor of Lethbridge.
18. Who are the executive officers of the UofL Geography Club? List their names.

20. What is the original name of 5th Street S?

27. Name the FM frequency used by the UofL radio.
28. What phrase is at the top of the plaque on the twinning society sign? (see Question 42)
29. What is the penalty for violating the "Unsightly property" Bylaw in Lethbridge (Number 5630)?
30. Take a picture of the historic Clock Tower in Lethbridge. (See also Question 51)
31. Fill in the blank. The Clock Tower building now used as a _____.
32. What special satellite technology is used to take images received by the "Golf Ball"?

33. Take a picture with the chair of the UofL Geography Department.
34. Take a picture of at least one team member in front of City Hall archway.
35. Take picture of at least one team member with the horse statue outside city hall. Bonus 2 points for posing with the cowboy or riding the horse.
36. Take pictures of each team member in front of Galt Museum trolley.
37. Visit a park in Lethbridge and take photos of each group member in the park. The park name must be visible in the photos, and/or a distinctive feature of the park. A bonus of 5 points will be awarded for each subsequent park visited and photographed in this way.
38. What quote appears at the top of the Eternal Flame at the Mountain View Cemetery?
39. What are the names of the other three cemeteries in Lethbridge?
40. How many off-leash dog parks are in Lethbridge and where are they located (name parks)?
41. Submit a local bus transfer.
42. Find the twinning society sign on the corner of 4th Ave S and 6th Street S. Write down the name of the Russian City and the distance to it.
43. What did the Medicine Stone say to the Native hunter in a dream? (look for the answer near the Fort Whoop-up parking lot.)
44. What phrase is written on the back of the water fountain in front of Lethbridge College?
45. What purpose did the abandoned metal structures on the coulees above Bridge Drive once serve?
46. What is the date of the highest wind gusts recorded in Lethbridge and how strong were they? Hint: try the Lethbridge Wind Gauge at the Chinook County Tourist Information Center.
47. Submit a receipt for a Zoo Brew at The Zoo. Additional 5 points for a photo of the team drinking.
48. If you find yourselves near the High Level Bridge, take a picture from underneath the bridge with the trestles lined up.
49. Find the UofL Security Office and take a picture with one of the UofL security officer.
50. Photo of the entire team eating at the UofL Cafeteria.
51. If you are close to the historic Clock Tower in Lethbridge, take a picture of the clock at 19:12 hr.
52. Take a picture of at least one team member in front of the Lethbridge Brewery Gardens (located near the police station).
53. Did you know that the University of Lethbridge has a Library Time Capsule. Within this capsule, find the Hammond World Atlas. Name the authors.
54. The University of Lethbridge also has a Faculty of Fine Arts and houses an Art Gallery. Find two outdoor visual art works on the Lethbridge campus, take a picture, and give the names of the artists.



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10 Points:

55. Get a free "Parks and Pathways Map" from the Lethbridge Tourist Info office with a stamp from the office. The Lethbridge Tourist Information office is located on Scenic Drive.
56. Group picture of the entire team wearing badges inside the Markin Hall building.
57. Take a team photo in front of the "Golf Ball" (north of the Water Building).
58. Submit proof of admission to the Galt Museum (bonus 5 points if each member has a receipt).
59. Find an example of terracing somewhere in the coulees around Lethbridge and take a photo of them.
60. Find an example of slumping in the Lethbridge coulees and take a photo of it.
61. Bring an "Amygdaloidal basalt" rock from the shore of the Oldman River (e.g. Indian Battle Park)
62. Build a snowman! (if there is snow around)...
63. Take a picture of at least one group member drinking a shot at the Owl Acoustic Lounge. Additional 5 bonus points for the whole team doing one.
64. Submit proof of admission to the Southern Alberta Art Gallery (SAAG).
65. If you find yourself in the Lethbridge Water Tower, you will find that it has been turned into a restaurant and a lounge. Take a scenic photograph from within the establishment.
66. Visit the Park Place mall and speak to the Information personnel. Sneak a picture of this encounter.
67. Take a picture of at least one team member with the coalmine cart in the Coalbanks Kiosk under the train bridge.
68. Identify the typo made in the plaque commemorating the "First Flight Across the Rockies". The plaque can be found at the Galt Gardens.
69. Who created the miner statue in the Lethbridge College foyer?
70. Submit a team photo singing karaoke. Name the establishment.
71. Get a chip from Casino Lethbridge and submit it.
72. Take a photo of at least one member with the Lethbridge Wind Gauge (located at the Chinook County Tourist Information Centre).
73. Benchmarks are used to create Datums, which are then used for map making. If you find yourself at the Galt Gardens, take a picture of the benchmark along with at least one team member.
74. The railroad played a vital role in building and connecting small communities in Southern Alberta. There is a steam locomotive found within the vicinity of the Park Place Mall. Take a team photo of this local beast along with the locomotive number.

20 points:

75. Dress up in funny costumes at the Banquet (at least 5 students of your Geography club/course).
76. Photo of the entire team sleeping on a table at the UofL Library.
77. Roll down the Sugar Bowl hill in Ravine Park and shoot a video of it!
78. The University of Lethbridge has a live webcam facing the coulee just behind the University Hall. The task is to get one member to figure out how to get themselves within the webcam range. 79. Get a parking ticket on Thursday or Friday from the UofL Security.
80. Convince one of your professors to wear a headlamp for at least an hour during the Banquet.



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81. How many photos are on the memorial for the WWII PoW Camp 133 memorial? (Hint, it is located near the fire department training center at 49°42'21.50"N, 112°48'0.00"W)
82. If you prefer to find another benchmark, then make your way to Whoop-Up walkway (overpass) along University Drive. Take a picture of this benchmark with a peace sign.
83. Find this mural in downtown Lethbridge and submit a photo of at least one team member in front of it:



BONUS POINTS (25 points each):

84. Submit a 3-5 minute video of your team showcasing "A Day in the Life of a Geography Student." Post this on YouTube with WDCAG2013 as keyword. Send the URL to wdcag2013@gmail.com. **NOTE: The videos will be shown at the WDCAG Banquet.**
85. Write a paragraph (300 words) about what you have learned during your field trip. Submit this piece and receive 25 points. If additional members of your team submits a piece, additional 5 points will be awarded to each team member.
86. Additional 25 points will be awarded when ALL five (or more) of your Geography Club/Course Union members are dressed in the same theme at Question 75.
87. Take a picture of a TEAM member holding an animal at the Helen Schuler Coulee Centre. If a member holds a snake or a spider, an additional 10 points will be awarded on top of the 25 bonus points.
