**Notes**

<b>General Requirements</b>	<p>Students must complete at least four courses (12.0 credit hours), including at least one course (3.0 credit hours) at the 3000/4000 level.</p> <p>Students may not double count courses required for the minor in fulfilling requirements for their major or second minor. The four courses comprising the minor must be distinct from any such major or second minor requirements.</p> <p>For students who complete the required courses, the minor will be acknowledged on the official transcript.</p> <p>Minors are available in the Bachelor of Management degree, Post-Diploma Bachelor of Management degree, Professional Diploma in Accounting, Management Certificate and second degrees in Management.</p> <p>Some minors are available in the combined degrees programs. Please refer to Part 13 of the University of Lethbridge Calendar for full details.</p>
<b>Minimum Grade</b>	<p>A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in all courses taken towards a Management Minor.</p>
