

SPHERE GUIDELINES

- 1. Hand hygiene must be performed upon entry to SPHERE and before exiting at the end of every class.
- 2. Sturdy, closed-toe / closed-heel footwear must be worn in SPHERE at all times. Flip flops, sandals, slip-ons, bare feet and stocking feet are prohibited.
- 3. Proper procedures for reporting injuries are provided in the OH&S binder in the SPHERE storage room. All injuries must be reported to the instructor at the time of the occurrence.
- 4. Inappropriate or unprofessional conversation during class time is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- 5. All discussions within SPHERE must observe the principles of privacy and confidentiality.
- 6. Students and instructors will be conscious of the noise level within SPHERE and in the hallway and keep all unnecessary noise to a minimum.
- 7. SPHERE is a scent-free environment.
- 8. Taking pictures in SPHERE is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Food and beverages must be left on desks. Beverages must be kept in covered containers.
- 10. Students are not permitted in SPHERE without an instructor or SPHERE lab tech in attendance.
- 11. Lying or sitting on beds is permitted only while practicing a nursing skill. Shoes must be removed when lying on beds.
- 12. Sitting on floors, desks or beds within SPHERE is prohibited. Please use chairs.
- 13. Floors and walkways are to be kept clear at all times. Backpacks and purses must be kept in lockers or on the back countertop / shelving, only. Desks / chairs must be kept far enough away from beds to ensure a clear pathway.
- 14. Electrical cords must be plugged in at a safe working distance to avoid tripping hazards and are not to be stretched across walkways or work areas.
- 15. All equipment and supplies are to be returned to proper storage areas and carts. Work areas must be left neat and tidy at the end of every class.
- 16. Desks are to be arranged in rows as per LC room map. Adding desks or chairs to the rooms is not permitted.
- 17. All mannequins and equipment must be handled with care to avoid damage. Concerns or damages to equipment must be reported to the instructor or SPHERE staff immediately.
- 18. SPHERE doors must be kept locked at all times when not in use.
