This position will be responsible for engaging grades K-8 students in a variety of classroom workshops and on campus day camps between April 30 and August 24, 2018. As a member of Destination Exploration, you will become part of a national network of science outreach initiatives under Actua, Canada's largest STEM outreach organization.

Duties:

- Develop, prep and deliver our Traveling Lab Coats workshops, which are delivered to K-8 students in Lethbridge and its surrounding area (this program requires travel, which is reimbursed at a set mileage rate).
- Develop, prep and deliver week-long Learning Quest science camps on campus to children aged 5 – 16.
- Work collaboratively with other Leaders to develop activities and to create a safe, educational and fun environment for the campers.

- Effectively supervise all participants at all times while encouraging interactive learning and a team atmosphere.
