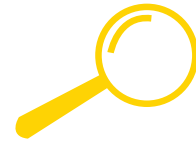

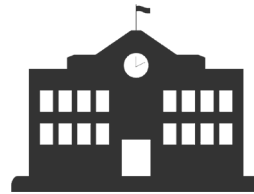

WHAT IS THE ULETHBRIDGE CO-OP ADVANTAGE

1. Flexible co-op programming
2. 4, 8, 12 or 16-month terms, starting in September, January or May
3. Co-op for all undergraduate majors (you don't have to go to multiple schools)
4. Advanced degree and masters level co-op students that can take on advanced projects and are highly independent in research/project design, implementation and analysis
5. Students are willing to relocate (70% of our students are not from Lethbridge)
6. Supported hiring processes (all free of charge); pre screened candidates, assistance with creating job postings, collecting applications & scheduling interviews
7. Ongoing support during all work terms
8. Students come prepared with extensive pre-work term & professional skills training
