Reporting to and working collaboratively with the Residence Life and Education Coordinators, the Peer Education Programmer (PEP) contributes to the planning and execution of Housing Services' Residence Life Wellness and Academic Success Plan, with an emphasis on academic success. It is a student leadership position dedicated to fostering an environment in residence where residence students can achieve academic success through initiatives, programming, resources, and spaces. The Peer Education Programmer is also a member of the Organization of Residence Students (ORS) Council.

The PEP is responsible for:

- * Liaising with on-campus academic services including but not limited to Co-operative Education, Student Success Centre, Writing Centre, Career and Employment Services, Counselling Services, and faculties, including professors and Academic Advising Offices
- * Understanding the support and programming available to the entire student body, and communicating this to Housing Services and ORS
- * Developing, promoting, and executing professional and peer-to-peer strategic programming and initiatives that will take place in residence (Student Success 101, Mentor program, etc.)
- * Continuing to enhance academic study spaces, resource libraries and information displays within residence
- * Liaising with University faculty members to organize events in residence
- * Other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- * Lived at least one semester in a post-secondary residence
- * Willing to apply for residence by March 1, 2020 and live in residence for the duration of the term
- * Excellent organizational, event planning, and interpersonal skills
- * Minimum 3.0 GPA is suggested, must supply working copy of transcript
- * Mandatory attendance for training: March 27-28th, 2020 and August 29th-September 4th, 2020
