This Program Transfer Guide is designed to help you plan your transfer program to the University of Lethbridge. The information should help you keep track of your progress. Please remember that this is only a guide. It must be used in conjunction with the Grande Prairie Regional College and University of Lethbridge Calendars and the Alberta Transfer Guide, which are the final authorities on all questions regarding program requirements and admission to University of Lethbridge programs. Students are also advised to consult the University of Lethbridge program planning tools available online at www.uleth.ca/ross/programs.

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Admission Requirements

GPA requirements differ for admission to the University of Lethbridge and admission to its Faculty of Education. The minimum GPA required for general admission to the University is 2.00 on eight or more transferable courses. Eligibility for admission to the Faculty of Education requires a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 on all U of L and transferable courses taken within the terms containing the last 14 graded university-level courses (42.0 credit hours). Additional admission requirements are outlined below. However, because admission to the Faculty is competitive within each teaching major, the actual GPA required for admission may be higher. For example, in highly competitive school subject areas such as English, Physical Education, and Social Studies, the GPA required for admission may be well above the minimum requirement.

Students must meet the following minimum qualifications for admission to the Faculty of Education:

1. Completion of at least 14 graded university-level courses (42.0 credit hours)—a maximum of 15 Arts and Science courses (45.0 credit hours) and 5 Education courses (15.0 credit hours) may be transferred to the U of L.
2. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all U of L and transferable courses taken within the terms containing the last 14 graded university-level courses (42.0 credit hours). All courses must be graded with the exception of Education 2500.
3. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all graded courses comprising the major, including all transferable courses. Admission requirements for the major may be met in one of the following ways:

- Completion of at least five term courses in a single discipline major.
 - Completion of at least 8 courses in the 16-course General Major, including at least four courses in the main teaching subject area.
 - Completion of at least 8 courses in the 16-course multidisciplinary major (Canadian Studies/Social Studies Education), including at least four courses in the main teaching subject area.
4. Credit in Education 2500 - Practicum I - Orientation to Teaching (GPRC: ED 2530) including a favourable recommendation from the instructor. This course may be completed at Grande Prairie Regional College and transferred to the University. You are strongly advised to contact an Academic Advisor at either institution for advice about completing Education 2500.
 5. Completion of an Additional Admission Requirement for the Native Education Major:
 - Native Education - completion of three of the seven courses required in the school subject minor. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 (on the U of L 4.00 scale) is required on all graded courses comprising the minor.

Note: *Students are encouraged to consult early with the Faculty of Education, Student Program Services, to ensure they have completed all necessary requirements for admission to the Faculty of Education.*

Application and Document Deadlines

You are encouraged to apply well ahead of the application deadlines. For detailed information, please visit our website www.uleth.ca/ross/admissions/apply or contact the Admissions Office at the U of L (SU140 | phone: 403-382-7134). Admission decisions are based on the information available at the time the application is reviewed. Conditional Offers of Admission may be issued in anticipation of fulfillment of the admission requirements by the appropriate deadline. Courses taken in the summer term that immediately precedes your admission to the fall term at the U of L must be complete before the start of the term and will be used to determine a final admission GPA.

Transfer Credit

Transfer credit is awarded upon admission to the U of L as per the Alberta Transfer Guide (transferalberta.alberta.ca) or U of L Transfer Credit Equivalencies Database (www.uleth.ca/ted). The minimum grade required for a course to be transferred to the U of L is a 'D'.

Unspecified course credit (1xxx, 2xxx, etc.) means that the University of Lethbridge does not offer the same course you transferred in, but we recognize and treat it as a university-level course. An unspecified course may not meet a specific course requirement. For example, if ANTH 1000 is required in your program, you may not use ANTH 1xxx to fulfill that requirement. Please contact an Academic Advisor in the Faculty of Arts and Science or Faculty of Education for more information.

Year of Calendar

A student admitted to a program offered by the U of L is governed by program requirements of the University Calendar in effect at the time of admission. If you wish to follow the program requirements of an earlier Calendar, contact your Faculty Student Program Services upon admission to the U of L.

Degree Requirements

Bachelor of Arts and Science Degree Requirements

1. Completion of at least 30 courses (90.0 credit hours) from disciplines offered by the Faculty of Arts and Science or the Faculty of Fine Arts with a GPA of at least 2.00.
2. Completion of the Liberal Education List Requirement.
3. Not more than 10 courses (30.0 credit hours) completed at the 1000 level (or lower) for credit towards the degree, excluding Activity courses (labelled PHAC and MUSE) and courses numbered in the range of 0520 to 0530.
4. Completion of at least 10 courses (30.0 credit hours) from disciplines offered by the Faculty of Arts and Science or the Faculty of Fine Arts at the 3000/4000 level, excluding Activity courses (labelled PHAC and MUSE).
5. Not more than three Independent Study courses (9.0 credit hours) may be completed for credit toward the degree.
6. Not more than three Disciplinary Credit Applied Studies courses (9.0 credit hours) may be completed for credit towards the degree. Students may, in addition, complete Applied Studies 2000, 2001, 2010, and 2011.
7. Not more than 17 courses (51.0 credit hours) may be completed from any one discipline.
Note: Disciplines are identified by a specific course label (e.g. KNES, ASTR, and HIST are separate disciplines).
8. Not more than six credit hours in Activity courses (i.e. courses labelled PHAC and MUSE) may be completed for credit towards the degree, except for Kinesiology majors (not more than 15.0 credit hours) and Music majors (not more than 12.0 credit hours).

1. Residence Requirement:

Degree: At least 15 courses (45.0 credit hours) offered by the Faculty of Arts and Science or the Faculty of Fine Arts must be completed at the University of Lethbridge.

Major: At least half of the courses required in the major must be completed at the University of Lethbridge.

1. Application and admission to the Faculty of Education.
2. Completion of the equivalent of 20 Education courses including: Education 2500
* Professional Semesters I, II, and III
One Education Foundation course
Three Education electives
** Students entering the Faculty of Education should note that practicum placements include locations outside of Lethbridge. Students must be prepared to travel. Some locations require relocation Monday to Friday.
While not an admission requirement to the Faculty of Education, school jurisdictions and schools require a criminal record check (or equivalent) from student teachers prior to practicum. The student is responsible for the cost of obtaining such documentation. Please contact the Faculty of Education, Student Program Services, for more information in this regard.*
3. Maintenance of a program GPA of 2.50 in Education courses.
4. Completion of the appropriate Education major as defined by the program, and a cumulative GPA of 2.50 in the courses comprising the major.
5. Completion of the Liberal Education List Requirement.
6. Residence requirement: At least 15 courses (45 credit hours) in Education must be completed at the University of Lethbridge.

Choosing an Education Major

The Faculty of Education offers 11 different majors that correspond to teaching subjects in Alberta schools (see p. 155 in the 2018/2019 University of Lethbridge Calendar for a listing). In highly competitive teaching majors, the GPA for admission may be above the minimum requirements.

Choosing Courses Outside the Major

Students sometimes find that their initial objective to teach only at the elementary or secondary school level is later modified or even completely changed. Students are therefore encouraged to select courses that will prepare them for teaching in a variety of situations.

Education Minors

Minors are optional, except for students pursuing the Native Education major. The Faculty of Education offers 18 minors (see p. 159 in the 2018/2019 University of Lethbridge Undergraduate Calendar and Course Catalogue for a listing). A minor consists of five non-Education courses (excluding those used in the major) and one curriculum and instruction Education course (to be completed after admission to the Faculty of Education). For all majors, Education students may not include, in any minor, courses which are included in the major.

Education Specializations

The Faculty of Education offers two specializations:

- Inclusive Education
- Technology in Education

The specializations consist of four courses and the corresponding Professional Semester III Special Focus Internship.

Liberal Education List Requirement (Lib Ed Requirement)

The Liberal Education List Requirement (Lib Ed Requirement) is a 12-course requirement (36.0 credit hours) for all University of Lethbridge undergraduate students. It is based on the liberal education philosophy of the University and is designed to ensure that students acquire breadth of knowledge encompassing a wide range of disciplines. The Lib Ed Requirement must be completed by the time of graduation. To meet the Lib Ed Requirement, you must complete four courses (12.0 credit hours) from each of the following three groups that will also meet degree requirements. See the appropriate faculty/school sections in the University of Lethbridge Calendar and Course Catalogue for a listing of the disciplines that pertain to each faculty/school and program. Courses required for the major and/or minor may be used to satisfy the Lib Ed Requirement. If a Grand Prairie Regional College course is being used to meet the Lib Ed Requirement, it must transfer appropriately as indicated below.

For **Combined Degrees programs with Education**, Lib Ed Requirement courses transferring as ABHL, ADCS, CDEV, CRED, HLSC, MGT, NURS, PUBH, or TREC may *only* count towards the degree requirements in the B.Mgt./B.Ed. program.

Only four courses (12.0 credit hours) in total from the Faculty of Education (EDUC), Faculty of Health Sciences (ABHL, ADCS, HLSC, NURS, PUBH, and TREC), and the Dhillon School of Business (MGT) may be counted towards the Liberal Education List Requirement.
