Post-Diploma Bachelor of Fine Arts - Art

This Program Transfer Guide is designed to help you plan your transfer program to the University of Lethbridge. The information should help you keep track of your progress. Please remember that this is only a guide. It must be used in conjunction with the Grande Prairie Regional College and University of Lethbridge Calendars and the Alberta Transfer Guide, which are the final authorities on all questions regarding program requirements and admission to University of Lethbridge programs. The Post-Diploma Bachelor of Fine Arts - Art program at the University of Lethbridge is an opportunity to obtain a degree that complements and enhances your diploma studies. Advisors in the Faculty of Fine Arts at the University carefully examine your Visual Arts and Design Diploma and create a list of courses specifically tailored to your area of focus. These courses will be chosen from among those required for the four-year B.F.A. - Art.

### **Admission Requirements**

---

You may complete a B.F.A. - Art within two years or 20 courses if you possess a two-year Visual Arts and Design Diploma from Grande Prairie Regional College. Admission will be based on a combination of grade point average (a minimum of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale) and submission of a portfolio (see below).

### **Portfolio Requirements**

Students applying for the Art Studio major must submit a portfolio. Portfolio requirements can be found on p. 168 of the 2018/2019 University of Lethbridge Calendar and at [www.uleth.ca/finearts/departments/art/admissions](http://www.uleth.ca/finearts/departments/art/admissions).

### **Application and Document Deadlines**

You are encouraged to apply well ahead of the application deadlines. For detailed information, please visit our website [www.uleth.ca/ross/admissions/apply](http://www.uleth.ca/ross/admissions/apply) or contact the Admissions Office at the U of L (SU140 | phone: 403-382-7134). Admission decisions are based on the information available at the time the application is reviewed. Conditional Offers of Admission may be issued in anticipation of fulfillment of the admission requirements by the appropriate deadline. Courses taken in the summer term that immediately precedes your admission to the fall term at the U of L must be complete before the start of the term and will be used to determine a final admission GPA.

### **Year of Calendar**

A student admitted to a program offered by the U of L is governed by program requirements of the University Calendar in effect at the time of admission. If you wish to follow the program requirements of an earlier Calendar, contact your Faculty Student Program Services upon admission to the U of L.

### **Please Note**

---

The Visual Arts and Design Diploma program is outlined in the Grande Prairie Regional College Calendar. Read the appropriate section of the Calendar carefully. If you have any questions, please contact an Academic Advisor at Grande Prairie Regional College.

The Liberal Education List Requirement must be met by all students at the University of Lethbridge. This requirement is based on the liberal education philosophy of the University and is designed to ensure that students acquire breadth of knowledge encompassing a wide range of disciplines.

You will complete the Liberal Education List Requirement during your post-diploma studies. However, Social Science or Science courses you take at Grande Prairie Regional College may count towards this requirement. This will reduce the number of Liberal Education courses you have to complete at the University of Lethbridge, but it will not reduce the number of courses you must complete to fulfill your degree requirements.

Typically, the 20 course Post-Diploma B.F.A. - Art will include a minimum of 12 courses in Art, Art History, and/or Museum Studies and 8 courses that will be taken to meet the Liberal Education List Requirement and/or chosen electives. Each program is individually tailored depending on the content of the diploma.
