Admission Requirements

If you have completed three or more transferable term courses, you are considered to be a New Transfer applicant. Admission requirements vary depending on the number of transferable, post-secondary courses completed. For information on New Transfer Admissions please visit our website www.uleth.ca/ross/admissions/undergrad/transfer or contact Admissions at the University of Lethbridge.

Application and Document Deadlines

You are encouraged to apply well ahead of the application deadlines. For detailed information, please visit our website www.uleth.ca/ross/admissions/apply or contact the Admissions Office at the U of L (SU140 | phone: 403-382-7134). Admission decisions are based on the information available at the time the application is reviewed. Conditional Offers of Admission may be issued in anticipation of fulfillment of the admission requirements by the appropriate deadline. Courses taken in the summer term that immediately precedes your admission to the fall term at the U of L must be complete before the start of the term and will be used to determine a final admission GPA.

Transfer Credit

Transfer credit is awarded upon admission to the U of L as per the Alberta Transfer Guide (transferalberta.alberta.ca) or U of L Transfer Credit Equivalencies Database (www.uleth.ca/ted). The minimum grade required for a course to be transferred to the U of L is a 'D'. However a minimum grade of 'C-' is required in Statistics 1770; Economics 1010 and Economics 1012; Writing 1000 OR a university English course; all Management courses, including those cross-listed with Management; and all courses in the major marked with an asterisk (*) in order to meet degree requirements.

Unspecified course credit (1xxx, 2xxx, etc.) means that the University of Lethbridge does not offer the same course you transferred in, but we recognize and treat it as a university-level course. An unspecified course may not meet a specific course requirement. For example, if MGT 2400 is required in your program, you may not use MGT 2xxx to fulfill that requirement. Please contact an Academic Advisor in the Dhillon School of Business for more information.

Year of Calendar

A student admitted to a program offered by the U of L is governed by program requirements of the University Calendar in effect at the time of admission. If you wish to follow the program requirements of an earlier Calendar, contact your Faculty Student Program Services upon admission to the U of L.

Degree Requirements

Bachelor of Management

1. Completion of at least 40 courses (120.0 credit hours) with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.00 and a minimum graduation grade point average of 2.00 on the last 20 courses taken at the U of L.
2. Completion of the Liberal Education List Requirement (see p. 5 of this guide).
3. Not more than 12 courses (36.0 credit hours) may be completed at the 1000 level (or lower) for credit towards the degree, excluding Activity courses (labelled PHAC and MUSE) and courses numbered in the range of 0520 to 0530.
4. Not more than six credit hours in Activity courses may be taken for credit towards the degree.
5. **Residence Requirement:**
Students must complete at least 20 University of Lethbridge courses including 10 3000/4000-level courses in Management. In addition to meeting the residence requirement for their program, students in the Accounting major must complete five of the following courses at the University of Lethbridge: MGT 3100, MGT 3101, MGT 3130, MGT 3131, MGT 3151, MGT 3160, MGT 3170, MGT 3180, MGT 4110, MGT 4130, MGT 4151, MGT 4160.
6. **Minimum Grade Requirement:**
A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in ECON 1010; ECON 1012; STAT 1770; WRIT 1000 OR a university English course; all Management courses, including courses cross-listed with Management; and all courses in the major marked with an asterisk (*) in order to meet degree requirements.
7. **Time Limit for Degree:**
All degree requirements must be completed within 10 years after acceptance into the Dhillon School of Business.

Liberal Education List Requirement (Lib Ed Requirement)

The Liberal Education List Requirement (Lib Ed Requirement) is a 12-course requirement (36.0 credit hours) for all University of Lethbridge undergraduate students. It is based on the liberal education philosophy of the University and is designed to ensure that students acquire breadth of knowledge encompassing a wide range of disciplines. The Lib Ed Requirement must be completed by the time of graduation. To meet the Lib Ed Requirement, you must complete four courses (12.0 credit hours) from each of the following three groups that will also meet degree requirements. See the appropriate faculty/school sections in the University of Lethbridge Calendar and Course Catalogue for a listing of the disciplines that pertain to each faculty/school and program. Courses required for the major and/or minor may be used to satisfy the Lib Ed Requirement. If a Grand Prairie Regional College course is being used to meet the Lib Ed Requirement, it must transfer appropriately as indicated below.

For **Combined Degrees programs with Education**, Lib Ed Requirement courses transferring as ABHL, ADCS, CDEV, CRED, HLSC, MGT, NURS, PUBH, or TREC may *only* count towards the degree requirements in the B.Mgt./B.Ed. program.

Minors

In keeping with the principles of liberal education, the University of Lethbridge offers minors in a variety of areas. Minors are available across Faculties and provide students in undergraduate programs the opportunity to pursue their interests in an area or areas distinct from their chosen major and degree program.

A minor is a defined set of six courses, designed to provide depth in a particular discipline, study in an interdisciplinary area, or focus on a theme-related topic. Students may wish to consider declaring a minor for a variety of reasons: to enhance depth of knowledge in a diverse area, to gain exposure to a range of perspectives, to build a foundation for an intended career, to pursue multiple passions, or to broaden talents.

Students may declare a maximum of two minors in a single program. For students who successfully complete the specified requirements, the minor(s) will be acknowledged on the official transcript.

Language Requirement:

In addition to completing an international exchange term as part of the major at the University of Lethbridge, students in the International Management major must complete three language courses (9.0 credit hours) in one of the following languages: French, Japanese, or Spanish.

Note: GPRC offers French language courses for use toward this major. Other languages are available at the U of L.

French:

Students are advised to consult a GPRC Advisor for assistance in choosing appropriate courses..

For students who have NOT completed French 30 or Français 30:
