The Post-Diploma Bachelor of Science in Computer Science at the University of Lethbridge is an opportunity to obtain a degree that complements and enhances your diploma studies. Courses in your program will be chosen from among those required for the four-year B.Sc. in Computer Science and will depend, in part, upon the courses you have completed within your diploma and your area of focus.

Admission Requirements

You may complete a B.Sc. in Computer Science within two years or 20 courses if you possess a two-year Diploma in Computer Systems Technology from Grande Prairie Regional College with a cumulative diploma grade point average of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale.

You are encouraged to apply well ahead of the application deadlines.
