Faculty of Education Admission

Students begin in the Pre-Post-Diploma program. After completion of one or two terms, including Education 2500, students must apply for admission to the Faculty of Education. To be considered for admission to the Faculty of Education, successful completion of the following is required:

- _____ **Education Admission GPA:** Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all U of L and transferable courses taken within the terms containing the last 14 courses (42.0 credit hours). If any part of the diploma falls within the last 14 courses (42.0 credit hours), the entirety of the diploma (i.e., diploma GPA) is included in the calculation. All courses must be graded.
- _____ Minimum of five courses (15.0 credit hours) in the major.
- _____ **Major GPA:** Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all graded courses comprising the major, including all transferable courses.
- _____ Credit in Education 2500 - Orientation to Teaching (or equivalent) prior to the fall program intake, including a favourable recommendation from the instructor.
