- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of at least eight Art, Art History, and/or Museum Studies courses (24.0 credit hours) at the 3000/4000 level.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of the Liberal Education List Requirement. A maximum of four courses from one department may be counted toward this requirement. See the 2023/2024 University of Lethbridge Calendar, School of Liberal Education for complete information.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A maximum of three Independent Study courses in Fine Arts.

## Faculty of Education Admission

To be considered for admission to the Faculty of Education, successful completion of the following is required:

**Note:** Due to course sequencing, the Faculty of Fine Arts recommends students to complete 30 courses prior to applying to the Faculty of Education.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 14 graded term courses (42.0 credit hours).
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Education Admission GPA:** Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all U of L and transferable courses taken within the terms containing the last 14 courses (42.0 credit hours). All courses must be graded.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Minimum of five courses (15.0 credit hours) in the major.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Major GPA:** Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all graded courses comprising the major, including all transferable courses.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Credit in Education 2500 - Orientation to Teaching (or equivalent) prior to the fall program intake, including a favourable recommendation from the instructor.
